### Olympia Farmers Market

The second largest farmers market in Washington State located at the Port peninsula in 1996. It offers fresh, top-quality regional produce, meats, seafood, breads and flowers, and various eateries, arts & crafts and live entertainment. Open 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. (April-Oct: Thurs-Sun; Nov-Dec: Sat-Sun).

### Hands On Children's Museum

### LOTT Water, Education & Technology (WET) Science Center

### Viewing Tower

360-degree view features the international seaport, Capitol Building, Budd Inlet, Olympic Mountains, Mt. Rainier, Capitol Lake and more.

### KGY/KAYO Radio

One of the Northwest's oldest radio stations. A Benedictine monk from St. Martin's University received KGY's call letters in 1922. Located at NorthPoint since 1960. KGY 95.3 FM and KAYO 96.9 FM.

## PARKS & TRAILS

Over 70% of Port Peninsula shoreline/waterfront provides public access.

### Port Plaza

Just north of the Percival Landing boardwalk on Budd Inlet, Port Plaza features Pacific Northwest-style landscaping, a public stage, viewing tower, 500 lineal feet of guest moorage and a park-like setting. Available for rent for public and private events: 360.528.8071.

### East Bay Overlook

A pocket park with panoramic view of the East Bay and beyond.

### Billy Frank Jr. Trail/Park

Over a mile of unpaved trail stretches along the shoreline between East Bay Drive/Olympia Avenue and ends at the scenic Billy Frank Jr. Park. This trail and park offer an educational journey of Billy Frank Jr., Squaxin Island Tribe, native plants and the importance of the salmon. ### Swantown Marina and Boatworks

### Public Launch

Local boaters enjoy the easy access and dual ramps of the Public Launch on the north end of Swantown Marina.

### Marine Fueling Station & Pump-Out

220' of fuel dock space includes gasoline, high flow diesel, ultra high flow diesel and two sewage pump-out stations. Most environmentally friendly and State-of-the-Art facility in Puget Sound.

### Olympia Area Rowing (OAR)

A rowing club that "promotes and provides competitive and recreational rowing for adults and youth in the local community, fostering sportsmanship, teamwork, athleticism, and camaraderie."

### Guest Moorage

Guest docks offer 70+ slips on concrete-topped floats for boats up to 100 feet in length. Shore power included in nightly rate; 30 or 50 amp twist-lock plug needed. Reservations available.

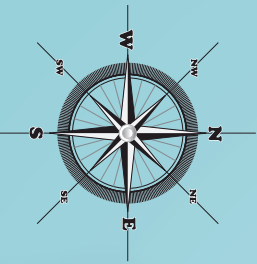
