Driving Southbound on I-5

- Take the TUMWATER BLVD. EXIT, EXIT 101, toward OLYMPIA AIRPORT.
- Turn LEFT onto TUMWATER BLVD. SW.
- Turn RIGHT onto HARPER ST. SW.
- Turn RIGHT onto 74TH AVE. SW.
- End at 1620 74th Ave SW, Tumwater, WA.

Driving Northbound on I-5

- Take I-5 North.
- Take the TUMWATER BLVD. EXIT, EXIT 101, toward OLYMPIA AIRPORT.
- Turn RIGHT onto TUMWATER BLVD. SW.
- Turn RIGHT onto HARPER ST. SW.
- Turn RIGHT onto 74TH AVE. SW.
- End at 1620 74th Ave SW, Tumwater, WA.
