## **Port Updates Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements**

### **Annual updates do not affect plan's substance**

OLYMPIA – After the public hearing held at the Dec. 14, 2009 regular meeting, the Port of Olympia Commission approved the *2010 Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements (CSHI)* to incorporate the *2010 Capital Investment Plan* as adopted at the Nov. 23, 2010 regular meeting. The CSHI is a planning document required of ports under RCW 53.20.010.

In presenting the document to the Commission, Finance Director Kevin Ferguson said that although the plan had not changed in substance, it requires annual updates to reflect any capital project changes as well as any changes made to the maps that are included in the document.

The *2010 Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements* is in the same format as the 2009 document. It reflects maps from the Commission-approved *Development Guidelines*, and a list of 2010 capital projects. The 2010 document is available to the public at
