**BOAT LAUNCH PARKING TO BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED
KGY to construct radio tower in new boat launch parking lot**

When Port of Olympia completed the Cascade Pole Cleanup Phase 2, it opened up land at NorthPoint near Swantown Marina for new public uses. The capped area is now a boat launch parking lot with a small area leased by KGY for its new radio tower. For three to five days during the week of May 11, the parking lot will be closed while KGY constructs the tower, safety barriers and other related installations.

All of the underground preparation for KGY's tower was completed during the capping of the site, so the remainder of the construction will not impact the site's cleanup systems and will not expose any site contaminants to the environment.
